



- Over 26000 rivers total length is about 60 000 km.
- 99% of rivers are short (less than 25 km long).
- Water resources are however distributed unevenly, being predominately located in the west.






- About 860 lakes;
- **43 reservoirs** created for hydro energy, irrigation and drinking purposes;
- Wetlands cover about 630 km2;
- About **730 Glaciers** accumulate **30 billion cubic meters** of ice;
- Natural supply of fresh **Ground Water** about **18000 million m³**;
- The whole observed supplies of water for consumption about **10600 million m³**;
- More than 1000 sources of Mineral Water;
- About 250 sources of Thermal Water.





Water Use



Water use in total 29756 mln.m³

- Hydropower 28952 mln.m³ (97%)
- Drinking water supply 414 mln.m³
- Industry 333 mln.m³
- Irrigation 57 mln.m³

Main polluters:

- Municipal wastewater 67%
- Thermal Power stations 31%
- Industry 2%
- Pollution from the illegal landfills Agricultural lends (non point sources of pollution)

- Nitrogen compounds;
- •Biochemical oxygen demand (BOD);
- •Suspended Solids.

Other Problems:


- High losses of water from municipal water use and irrigation;
