MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF STAR RATING (MFT ATTRIBUTES)

- Restaurants serving Halal and Non Halal Food must have separate kichen, storage facilities, washing facilities, utensils and equipments.
- **Kiblat Sign** Kiblat sign to be displayed on ceiling of every room
- Water Hose/bidet to be provided for ablutions
- Separate Compartment Halal & Non Halal
- Surau (Prayer Rooms)

Shariah-Compliant Hotel Attributes

- Halal food served in the main café/kitchen
- No prohibited food and beverages served, including in hotel fridge
- Quran (with translation) and prayer mat in the room
- Signage of the direction of the Qiblat
- Bed & toilet positioned away from Qiblat
- No gambling-related activities
- Prayer room provided at decent location
- Bidets in bathrooms
- Islamic/family entertainment only.
- Separation of recreational facilities for men and women including swimming pool, gym, spa etc.
- Options for all female or family floors

- Predominantly Muslim staff with proper Islamic code of dressing
- Guest dress code must be posted at the hotel entrance or lobby
- Islamic funding (hotel financed through Islamic financial instruments)
- Arts not to depict human or animal form
- Printed/updated prayer schedule in every hotel room
- Outlets selling Halal/Islamic related products such as Islamic books, CDs, Islamic attire, halal food and beverages or any other Islamic-related products







KEY CHALLENGES

- Acceptance of headquarters or accommodation provider owners
- Other guest's perception on the word 'Shariah'
- Current practices are sufficient for our target market
- Too risky to invest due to market uncertainties
- Attaining *Halal* certification
- Brand positioning does not suit Shariah compliance
- To comply would entail higher costs
- Might lose other target market
- Adhering to the strict requirements
