A Framework for Statistical Coordination among OIC Institutions



SESRIC made a presentation on the initiative of the OIC-SWG at the 24th Session of the COMCEC which was held on 20-24 October 2008 in Istanbul. The Session

- took note of and welcomed the establishment of the OIC-SWG
- appreciated the efforts of the SESRIC and the IDB and the other participating OIC institutions in the OIC-SWG
- called upon the NSOs and other relevant institutions in the member countries to actively cooperate with the OIC-SWG in the areas of data collection and technical cooperation towards realising consistent and high quality statistical database on various socioeconomic fields in the member countries that would make them better informed of each other's potentials and needs and, thus, facilitate their elaboration of cooperation projects and integration schemes.
- requested the SESRIC to report on the activities of the OIC-SWG to the annual sessions of the COMCEC and Follow-up Committee Meetings

Summary of the Conclusions and Recommendations of the 1st Meeting of OIC-SWG recommended to develop a common questionnaire and give the task to SESRIC and IDB for Socio-Economic and Financial Statistics.



SESRIC developed *Online Data Submission System*. In fact this is an *Online Questionnaire* since through this system member countries can enter thier data for 237 Socio-Economic variables for a period starting from 1970.

Experts Group Meeting on New Indicators



In the last decade, the shift in development landscape have been putting more pressure on the OIC NSOs to provide statistical services to support the demand for new indicators such as early warning systems, climate change and Islamic statistics. Accordingly, during the Meeting of the NSOs of the OIC Member Countries which was held in Istanbul on 22-23 March 2010, the representatives of the Meeting agreed to set up an Experts Group Meeting to look into these issues.

Experts Group Meeting on New Indicators



Summary of the Conclusions and Recommendations of the 2nd Meeting of OIC-SWG recommended to include to the common questionnaire Islamic Indicators such as zakah, awqaf, Islamic finance and banking which coincide with the indicators discussed during the Experts Group Meeting on New Indicators.

Definitions and Aggregation Methodologies

- Now it is possible to reach the definition of each indicator through BASEIND, a data dissemination system of SESRIC. This system currently contains data on 257 socio-economic variables under 17 categories for the 57 OIC Member Countries dating back to 1970.
- The definitions that exist in BASEIND are internationally accepted and used commonly by most of the international organizations but there is still debate going on standardization of the definitions globally. For this reason, SESRIC propose OIC-SWG to continue to discussing on them extensively.

OIC-SWG Newsletter



- SESRIC propose all of the OIC institutions to report their six months training programmes to be adjoined in the OIC-SWG Newsletter.
- SESRIC distributes this publication to all the NSOs of the member states, so that they can, hence, be informed of any planned training programme or statistical activity.
- More important than this, OIC institutions will have the chance to share, exchange and provide important data on these programmes and then it may be possible to combine some of the programmes if a coincide do exists.



SESRIC facilitates building of platforms to enhance cooperation among the NSOs of the OIC member countries. In this regard, the Centre organizes two important series of meetings annually:

- > Side event of the sessions of the UN Statistical Commission, which are held in New York annually
- Sessions of OIC Statistical Commission (OIC-SC) in collaboration with the Islamic Development Bank (IDB)



The OIC-SC can be a good platform where the NSOs can be presented the activities of OIC-SWG and can be asked for their valuable opinions. For this reason, SESRIC proposes a special session to be included within the agenda of the 1st Session of the OIC-SC which is planned to be held in the first half of 2011 in Istanbul related to the activities of OIC-SWG.
