Background to Kazakhstan ODA

- According to International ODA Experts' data as of 2013, since its independence Kazakhstan has provided more than 100 mln USD as humanitarian and development assistance.
- As a result of data collection of MFA from 1996 to 2014, information on assistance provided by Kazakhstan to Central Asian countries and beyond, as well as contributions to IOs it is about 350 mln USD.
- To strengthen its role as a donor, Kazakhstan is on the way to establish an ODA system and bring it in line with its foreign policy priorities.

Concept on ODA of Kazakhstan

Concept adopted on 9 April 2013 reflects the vision of development of national policies in respect of foreign countries in financial, technical and other assistance designed to promote:

- a) social and economic development of recipient countries;
- b) monitoring of assistance, and
- c) strengthening the role and authority of Kazakhstan in the international community.

Geographical priorities

- Central Asian countries and Afghanistan
- Developing countries of other regions

Law on ODA

Law adopted on 10 December 2014 to develop following sectors:

- 1) agriculture and food security;
- 2) environmental protection;
- 3) rational use of natural resources;
- 4) assistance to addressing of transboundary water problems;
- 5) facilitation of simplification of border-crossing procedures;
- 6) conflict management and security;
- 7) combating illegal drug trafficking and transnational crime;
- 8) education and science;
- 9) healthcare;
- 10) good governance;
- 11) support to business activity and improvement of business climate;
- 12) development of regional and international trade;
- 13) other sectors included in the main directions of state policy on ODA.

Kazakhstan is an “invitee” at DAC OECD since 2015

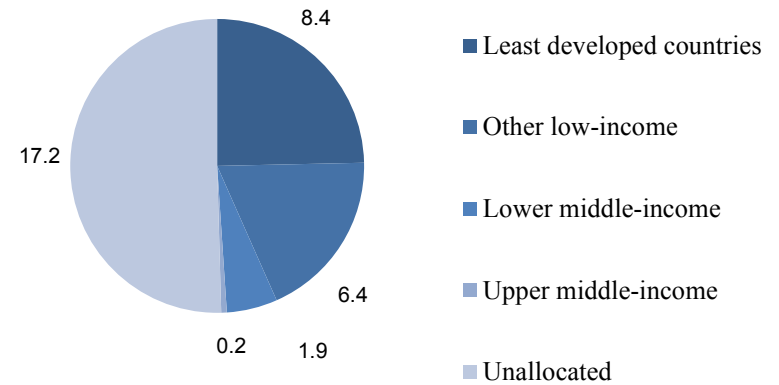

- In 2015, Kazakhstan’s net ODA amounted to USD 43 mln, compared to USD 33 mln in 2014, an increase of 43% in real terms

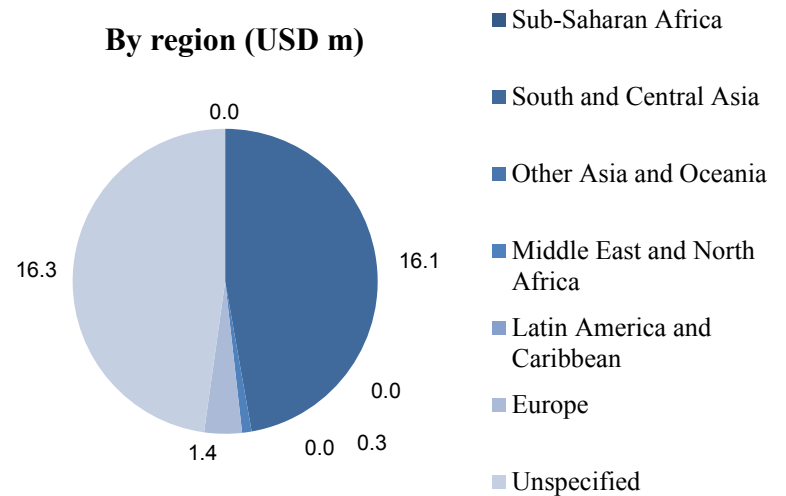

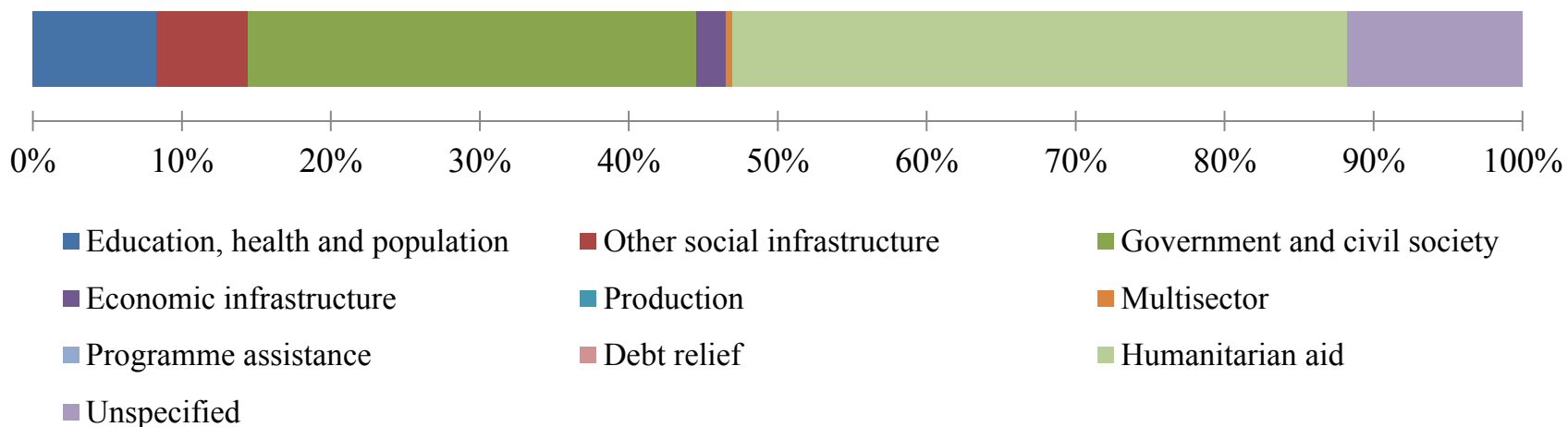


By region (USD m)

By sectors



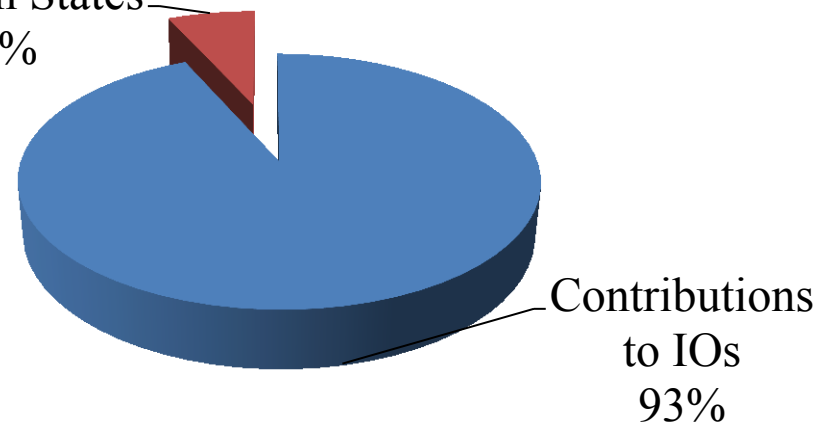

- On 23-28 April 2017, within the joint MFA-UNDP project **“Expert support for the establishment of a national ODA system”**, Kazakhstan financed a seminar on Drip Irrigation for 26 specialists and farmers from Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan in a cooperation with the Embassy of Israel of Kazakhstan/MASHAV lectures in Almaty and Astana.
- On 8-13 July 2017, within the tripartite project between MFA-UNDP-Embassy of Japan/JICA **“Promoting Kazakhstan’s ODA Cooperation with Afghanistan”**, the parties are conducting a seminar for about 30 Afghan women in the area of civil service through the Kazakhstan’s ODA in Astana.
