Pilot Case Study for Applicability of the Basic Level OStat Certification and Accreditation Processes, Report Writing and Willingness to Participate by WG3 Members

A. Summary

The eight members of WG3 were consulted on their willingness to participate in conducting the pilot case study on the applicability of the proposed Basic Level certification and accreditation processes, report writing for the case study and final report writing.

Two out of five tasks related to the Basic Level curriculum and examination by an Examination Committee was approved by the members. These tasks included development of model curriculum and listing of topics and available reference materials for Basic Level certification and accreditation. However, only Bahrain, SESRIC and IDP were willing to actively participate in all tasks of the Examination Committee for the purpose of a pilot case study.

Only Bahrain and SESRIC indicated their willingness to participate in all tasks of the temporary Program General Secretariat.

Egypt, IDB, SESRIC and Bahrain cited the importance of Compile and analyze the results of the Pilot Study from the Examination Committee and Program General Secretariat. Palestine, IDB, SESRIC and Bahrain cited the importance of finalizing the pilot case study report. However, only Bahrain and SESRIC indicated their willingness to participate in all tasks for Pilot Case Study Report preparation.

Bahrain, SESRIC and IDP indicated their willingness to participate in all tasks for WG3 Final Report preparation.

Three member countries (Qatar, Kazakhstan and UAE) did not favor a kick-off meeting.

Based on the results of the consultative questionnaires received from the members, there is a lack of willingness to participate in the pilot case study and report writing among the members.
