- Diversifying venues of the training WSs for more participation of m/c,




Advisory services:

<u>**Regular Budget:**</u> Funds for intergovernmental meetings, expert meetings, normative and operational work in the regular programme;


Regular Programme Technical Cooperation - RPTC:

DA projects: Funds aim at enhancing capacity of developing countries . through implementation of individual projects that intend at achieving a significant development impact







